Dear Ambuehl Parents & Guardians,



All Ambuehl students are permitted to ride bicycles to school to help ease vehicle traffic in the parking lot before and after school and to help keep our air cleaner. Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade bike riders must be accompanied by a parent or other adult. Students in 3rd, 4th, & 5th grade are not required to have adult supervision.

If you would like to have your child ride his/her bicycle to and from school, please review the following bicycle safety rules listed below with your child. Then complete and return the bicycle permission slip at the bottom of this letter to your child's teacher or the front office before your child rides a bike to and from school.

Ambuehl's bicycle safety rules and reminders are as follows:

- 1. Students and parents must walk their bicycles while on campus at all times.
- 2. Bicycle riders must enter and leave in front of the school.
- 3. Bicycles are not permitted in the playground area.
- 4. Students must lock their bicycles in the bicycle rack area during the school day. The school is not responsible for stolen bicycles. (There are always a few unlocked bicycles stolen each year.)
- 5. As per state law, student bicycle riders must wear a helmet.

For safety reasons, bicycle riders will be monitored to ensure that all students are following the rules listed above. Thank you for your support and understanding.
